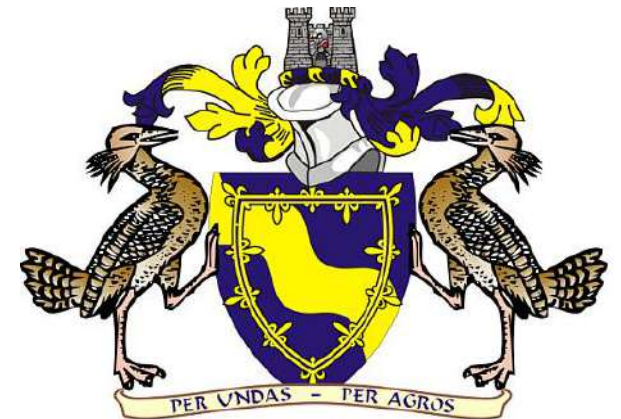
More seat allocations will be made soon.

Married in 1975, I have two children, three grandchildren and have lived in Rickmansworth, Hertfordshire since 1978.

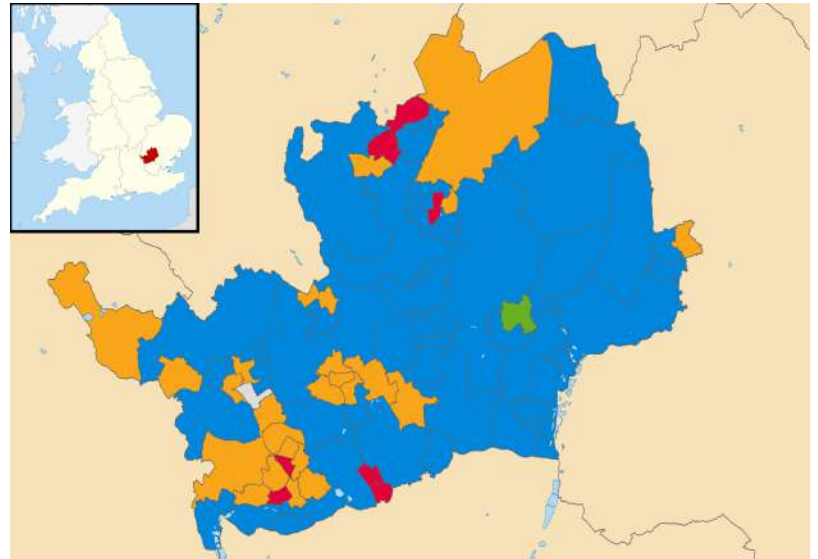
Since the period of the 2016 Brexit Referendum, I have become much more interested in politics & government.

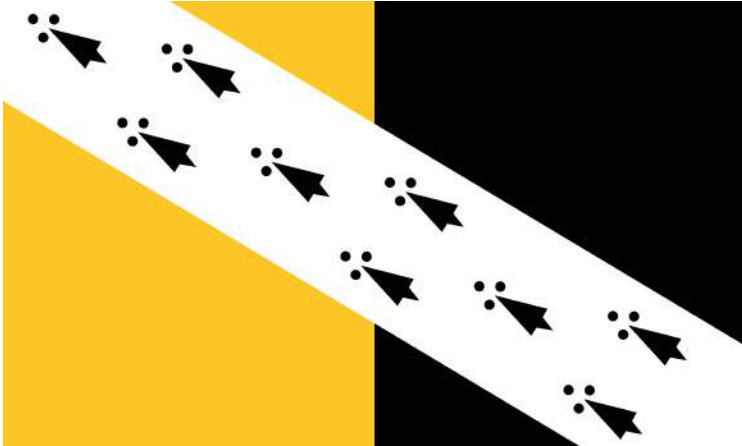
