We made a start campaigning as soon as the announcement was made as we don't want to waste any of the time available.

We had our campaign launch on the 17th June, with supporters, volunteers and spokespeople travelling from across the country to lend a hand.

We knocked on almost 3000 doors on day one & have so far been receiving a very positive response.

From now until the by-election, whenever it may be, we will be canvassing every Saturday & Sunday from 10-4pm. I will also be our knocking doors during the week so if you can join me on a weekday that would be great too.

All our Bedfordshire spokespeople have been out helping the Mid Beds campaign which is great. Not only is it superb to get their help but it is also great practice for their General Election campaigns next year.

We will be running street stalls across Mid Beds in the run up to the by-election, as well as action days for which we have been promised some high profile guest speakers to come along an lend us their support.

The ceremonial county of Cambridgeshire is divided into seven parliamentary constituencies. There are two borough constituencies and five county ...

The commission has proposed that the number of seats in Cambridgeshire be increased from 7 to 8, with the creation of the constituency of St Neots and Mid Cambridgeshire, resulting in significant changes to Huntingdon, North West Cambridgeshire, South Cambridgeshire and South East Cambridgeshire (to be renamed East Cambridgeshire).

The following seats are proposed:

Containing electoral wards in Cambridge

- Cambridge
- South Cambridgeshire (part)

Containing electoral wards in East Cambridgeshire

- East Cambridgeshire (part)
- Containing electoral wards in Fenland
- North East Cambridgeshire

Containing electoral wards in Huntingdonshire

- Huntingdon
- North West Cambridgeshire (part)
- St Neots and Mid Cambridgeshire (part)

Containing electoral wards in Peterborough

- North West Cambridgeshire (part)
- Peterborough

Containing electoral wards in South Cambridgeshire

- East Cambridgeshire (part)
- St Neots and Mid Cambridgeshire (part)

These will be the new Constituencies.


The Boundary changes have affected the work that our Constituency Spokespeople have been able to do, but you will see them out and about soon, in their updated Constituencies with more joining them very soon.

A few weeks ago, on a very sunny Saturday we had a great meeting of minds and it was the first opportunity many of us had to see each other in the flesh.




