



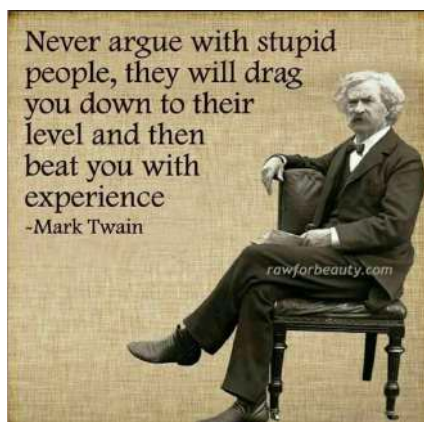

We will continue this progress during 2023. How high will we be polling by the end of the year?

Another busy month in the Eastern Region.

We welcome 3 new County Organisers, Keiron in Essex, Mick in Norfolk and Sean in Suffolk. Applications are coming in for the Cambridgeshire role, so I hope we will be up to full strength very soon. They will soon be contacting members in their Counties to introduce themselves.

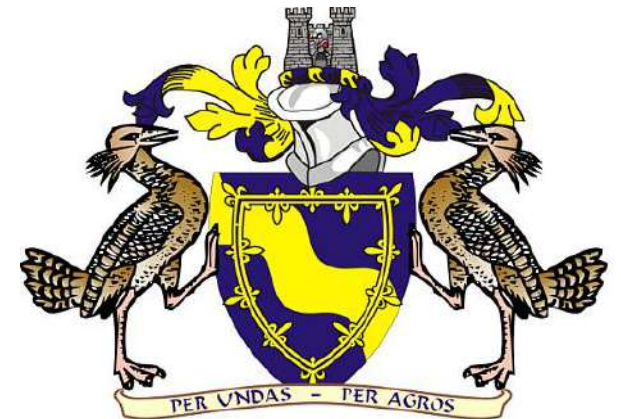

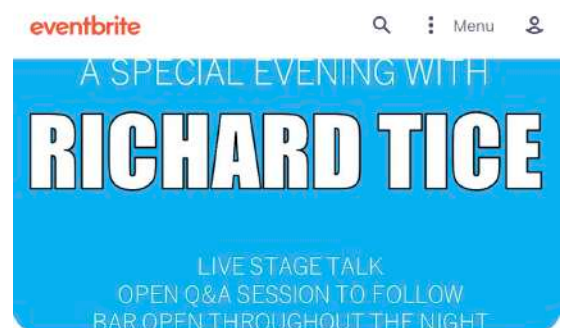

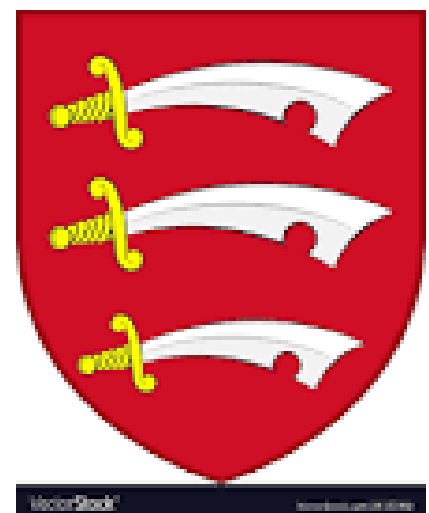

Hertfordshire covers 634.366 square miles with a population in 2021 of 1,184,365.

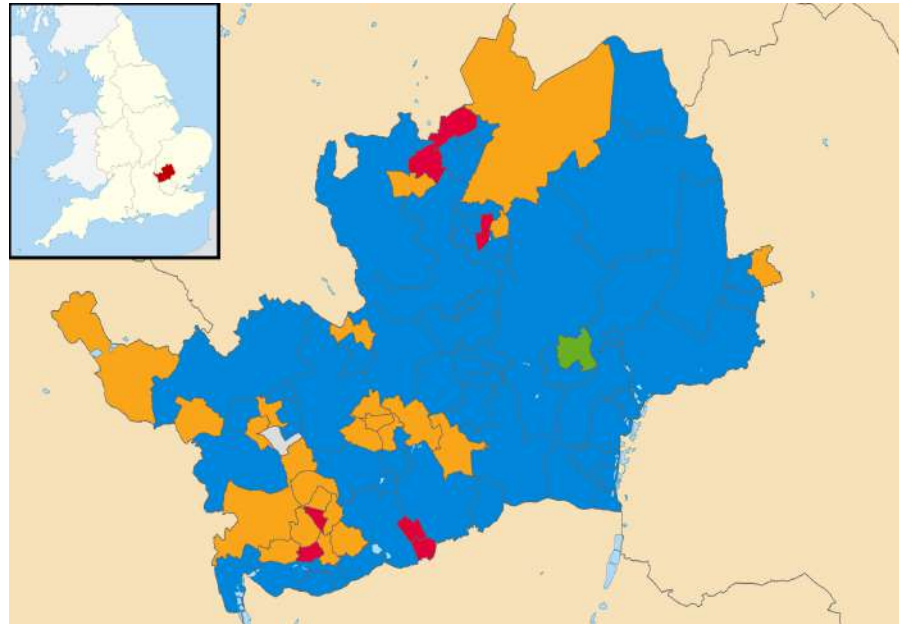
We have several spokespeople already nominated across Hertfordshire with several more to be announced in the near future.

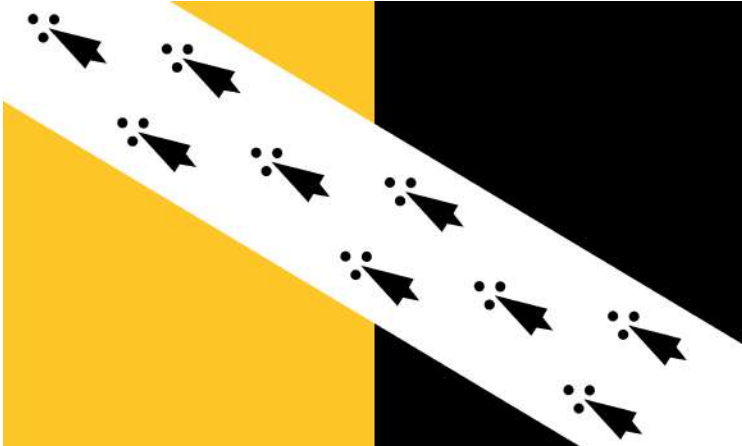

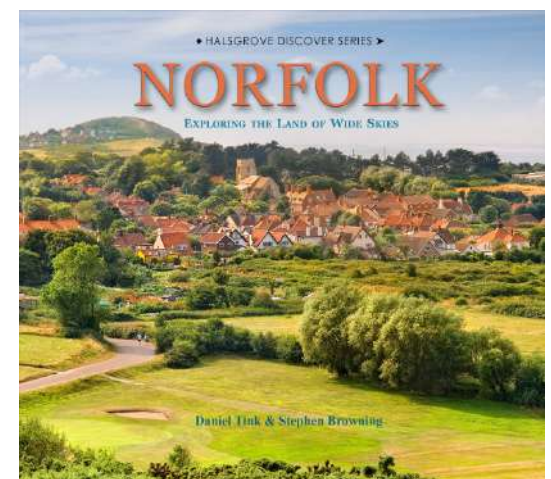

SPOKESPERSON SPOTLIGHT



Keiron McGill - Castle Point

My name is Keiron and I am the Reform UK candidate for Castle Point. It is fair to say that I have only become involved in the last year or so & I have absolutely no political background.

In fact you name a job, I have probably done it! From working 10-hour shifts in Burger King in Southend at the age of 16, to working the rides at Adventure Island in the late '90s, to nightshifts at Sainsbury's on Rayleigh Weir when my first son was born.

Currently I work in photocopier sales (a dubious enough industry for some!) and experience all the pressures of targets, fully aware that I could be unemployed with 3 poor months. I also set up a quiz night company in 2016 in order to reduce pressure on the day job, and can be seen doing the pubs in Essex on a monthly basis.

So believe me, I experience all the daily hardships as everyone which is why I feel Reform is by far the best party to work for us all in future.

I first became involved in 2021. I had a night time job delivering pizzas in Rayleigh and during the lockdowns it's no exaggeration to say it saved me - emotionally and financially. I saw at first hand the impact the lockdowns had on other drivers who were DJs, taxi drivers and printers. With my own entertainment company unable to run events I felt very passionately about the events at the time, and wondered who was actually standing up for us. I was politically homeless.

So I am delighted that Reform UK is that party I was looking for, that stands up for us. No further lockdowns, no vaccine mandates, a lower-tax economy to stimulate proper growth, common-sense policies on becoming energy independent & lowering costs...

That's just the tip of the iceberg and I feel there really is something for everyone.

I am fully committed to delivering the message and truly representing the people of Castle Point - and have already commenced leafleting the area along with a small & special team; have held informal meetings of supporters; and have established a community Facebook group that is growing by the day. For the first time in a long time, I really look forward to seeing what the future brings, and how we can be a force for changing it.

Voter ID

From 4 May 2023, voters in England will need to show photo ID to vote at polling stations in some elections.

This will apply to:

- Local elections
- Police and Crime Commissioner elections
- UK parliamentary by-elections
- Recall petitions

From October 2023 it will also apply to UK General elections.

Accepted forms of photo ID

You can use any of the following accepted forms of photo ID when voting at a polling station.

International travel

- Passport issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, a British Overseas Territory, an EEA state or a Commonwealth country

Driving and Parking

- Driving licence issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, or an EEA state (this includes a provisional driving licence)
- A Blue Badge

Local travel

- Older Person's Bus Pass
- Disabled Person's Bus Pass
- Oyster 60+ Card
- Freedom Pass
- Scottish National Entitlement Card
- 60 and Over Welsh Concessionary Travel Card
- Disabled Person's Welsh Concessionary Travel Card
- Senior SmartPass issued in Northern Ireland
- Registered Blind SmartPass or Blind Person's SmartPass issued in Northern Ireland
- War Disablement SmartPass issued in Northern Ireland
- 60+ SmartPass issued in Northern Ireland
- Half Fare SmartPass issued in Northern Ireland

Proof of age

- Identity card bearing the Proof of Age Standards Scheme hologram (a PASS card)

Other government issued documents

- Biometric immigration document
- Ministry of Defence Form 90 (Defence Identity Card)
- National identity card issued by an EEA state
- Electoral Identity Card issued in Northern Ireland
- Voter Authority Certificate
- Anonymous Elector's Document

You will only need to show one form of photo ID. It needs to be the original version and not a photocopy.

If you don't have an accepted form of photo ID

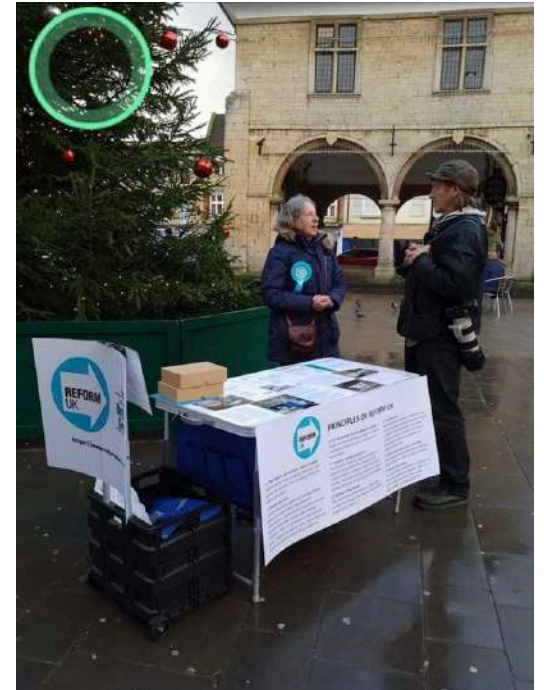
You can apply for a free voter ID document, known as a Voter Authority Certificate, if:

- you don't have an accepted form of photo ID
- you're not sure whether your photo ID still looks like you
- you're worried about using an existing form of ID for any other reason, such as the use of a gender marker

You need to register to vote before applying for a Voter Authority Certificate.
