Bedfordshire campaigning activity is progressing as the general election looms ever closer.

Following on from the failure of the spring Budget to improve the Tories fortunes (or polling numbers come to that) a May 24 election is looking much less likely than it was just a few weeks ago.

We are working towards an Autumn election in all probability and there is much to be done between now and then.

Campaigning isn't a solo activity, it is a team activity and the larger the team, the more people will hear our message, understand our policies, read our 'Contract with You' and ultimately vote Turquoise.

All 6 of our Bedfordshire PPCs have teams in place to help them leafleting, door knocking, manning street stalls, stuffing envelopes and doing all the tasks we need to get done.

The one thing I learned during the Mid bedfordshire by-election is that it doesn't matter how many people turn up, you will always need more of them, more often to achieve all your goals and targets.

Based on your location, your PPC will be notified that you have volunteered and provided with your details. They will then contact you with further details and arrange to get started.

Canvassing for a young party like Reform UK is very important.

Unlike the main legacy parties, we have a bigger challenge to introduce the party as well as our policies to prospective voters.

We are making a lot of progress in that regard and Reform UK is becoming a well known party, but despite already achieving 13% in the polls, there are still too many voters who don't know who we are.

Volunteers will change that for us. Together we will build the party ahead of the general election, but without your help it just isn't achievable.

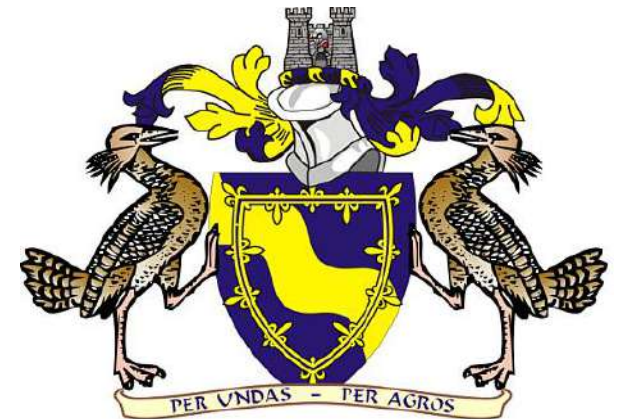

Hertfordshire County Overview

Herts County Council Feel the Effects of People Power!

In last months Reformer we announced our plans to stop the rollout of 20mph Zones across Hertfordshire, with £2.3 million earmarked for the project in HCC's 2024-25 budget.



John Dowdle (St Albans PCC) started a petition with the target of getting 1000 signatures in order to bring the issue firmly to the attention of councilors at County Hall.

With an aggressive email and social media push,

the whole team helped spread the word and Reformers across the county delivered! In two weeks the petition managed to achieve a whopping 1510 signatures!

As a result, on the 12th of March at 10am, John Dowdle will be speaking in person to present the petition to HCC's Highways & Transport Cabinet Panel at County Hall.

This campaign has sent off a shockwave across the county, with reports of the petition in Hemel Today, Bishop's Stortford Independent, Watford Observer and the St Albans Times, to name a few publications. With Reform putting on the pressure, local authorities are already backing down, with the Watford Observer reporting that Hertfordshire Council are ruling out blanket 20mph zones!

It would also appear that the petition has also sparked a raft of opposition petitions calling for traffic calming measures. With a Green Party activist and a Lib Dem Councillor doing petitions of their own, but with much less enthusiasm it would seem.

It's clear that we've sent a shot across the bows

of the blob in County Hall, and there will be much more from this story to come.

In other news, Darren Selkus has been hitting the streets in Hertsmere, spending 5 hours spreading the word to locals.

He had this to say: "Wow what a fantastic day. Big difference since the last time we did it. A lot more people knowing who Reform are and a lot of positive response. People are fed up with what we have."

Norfolk County Overview

Norfolk (/ˈnɔːrfək/ NOR-fək) is a ceremonial county in the East of England and East Anglia. It borders Lincolnshire and The Wash to the north-west, the North Sea to the north and east, Cambridgeshire to the west, and Suffolk to the south. The largest settlement is the city of Norwich.

The county has an area of 2,074 sq mi (5,370 km²) and a population of 859,400. It is largely rural with few large towns: after Norwich (147,895), the largest settlements are King's Lynn (42,800) in the north-west, Great Yarmouth (38,693) in the east, and Thetford (24,340) in the south. For local government purposes Norfolk is a non-metropolitan county with seven districts.

I hope to be able to introduce you to our new County Organiser very soon and with her help and that of the PPCs, we will be launching a series of meetings across the County in the spring.

I have been married for 43 years and have 2 children and four grandchildren.

I am originally from Durham, and attended a grammar school there before venturing south to study at London University for an honours degree.

I am now retired but have spent most of working life in the commercial world. I was Commercial Director of a very large retail company for many years before launching my own international consultancy business. I have a keen interest in West Suffolk, especially Newmarket. For over 30 years I have had, and continue to have, racehorses and bloodstock breeding interests in the town, and am a long term supporter of the National Stud.

I am standing for Reform as I despair at the current state of the two main parties who are, in effect, two sides of the same coin. Under the Tories we have ended up after 14 years with the highest levels of taxation, record immigration (both legal and illegal), net zero madness and massive waste in the public sector.

Expect more of the same under a Labour administration.

We need a re-set of British politics. First past the post makes it very difficult for new, challenging parties like ours, but the more people who vote for us and for change the more likely we are to achieve fair representation in parliament.

The Reform policies are just plain common sense and reflect the views of millions who voted Leave and who yearn for a balanced, fair, inclusive and rewarding society.
