



Rupert Lowe - Reform UK Agriculture Spokesman

I'm proud to write to you as Reform UK's agriculture spokesman. As a farmer and businessman myself I fully understand the challenges our agriculture sector faces. When the next general election comes this will be the third and final time I will stand for election. I'm doing this because reform is so vital to get our country back on track.

The old parties, together with the Civil Service, have failed us. It's time for a new approach and fresh blood to take our country forward. It is a case of "My Country, My Responsibility".

As we head into the next general election as a party spokesman it will be my job to set out what reform of our agriculture sector looks like. It is time to finally give our farmers and entire agricultural sector the support they have been denied by the failures of successive government policies.

I have developed a wide range of ideas but I will today highlight three that I know will provide a huge boost to the sector, our economy and our quality of life.

The rise in the cost of living is hitting families across the UK hard. The price of everything is increasing, especially our shopping bills. We have to improve our food security to keep the price British families pay to feed themselves down.

We do this by supporting our farmers and securing sensible deals overseas to reduce our reliance on Europe for the products we can't produce ourselves.

Producing food is pointless if we can't process it. Many people will be unaware of how successive governments have allowed food processing to move overseas, adding unnecessary logistical costs to the prices families pay on their shopping bills.

We can't have food security until we encourage that processing capacity back to the UK.

Farming works on very tight profit margins. Any issues in the harvest can mean life or death for agricultural businesses across the UK. One of the best tools farmers have to mitigate against such losses is diversification, but councils and planning permission often get in the way.

It's an issue popularised on Amazon Prime's Clarkson's Farm and an experience with which I'm personally all too familiar. We have to reform local planning laws to allow farmers to take the decisions they know are necessary to secure their businesses, and by extension the nation's food supply.

Only recently Conservative MP Jacob Rees-Mogg has spoken of how he wants to import 'hormone-injected beef' into the country from Australia. I couldn't disagree more. We can't have a prosperous nation without having a healthy nation.

Maintaining our high standards on food quality and labelling is a cornerstone of the policy platform I will develop.



One of the many reasons farmers are struggling is because they have to compete with cheaper, lower quality products from overseas. This does nobody any good.

We will do this by rejecting any attempts to water down food labelling, so consumers know what they are buying, and rejecting any attempts in future trade deals to introduce food products that are of lower quality, as the Tories are more than happy to do. It must be a level playing field for production with clear food labelling allowing consumer choice.

The fight for reform won't be easy, but it is worth it and we've done it before.

My first foray into politics was back in 1997 when I stood in that general election for the Referendum Party. The idea that we would eventually leave the EU seemed like a pipe dream then, but we finally achieved it on 31st January 2020.

There's still work to be done but it shows we can get the changes we know are so necessary for our country. And all of this is impossible without the hard work and dedication of our party's activists. We are currently bereft of able leadership!

Mid Bedfordshire - The By-Election Autopsy

From the moment when Nadine Dorries first resigned without resigning on June the 9th we commenced what turned out to be 132 days of uninterrupted canvassing.

16 hour days blurred into each other, as we knocked on 40,000 doors, chatted with many thousands of Mid Bedfordshire constituents & spread our message as far & wide as possible.

By-elections often attract far more activity than is possible in a General Election & the allowable spend is considerably higher at £100,000.

Additionally, with neither Labour or the Lib Dems standing aside in favour of the other we faced competing in a three way battle against parties with deep pockets and established resources in depth, all of which were convinced that they could win the fight.

We faced a different challenge to the established big three legacy parties in so much as that they are already widely known.

Our first task was to make Reform UK a household name in Mid Beds. I had already made a start in this regard last year, delivering an introduction leaflet to 60,000 homes as well as promoting our Facebook page quite hard across the constituency.

By October '22 we held our first dinner event with Richard coming along as our speaker. Advertising tickets proved to be a great opportunity to promote the Party across Mid Beds & the event was well attended with 50 guests.

activities. I was acutely aware that we could be facing a by-election at any time & had no time to waste.

I developed a series of 'talking heads' videos on a wide range of topics and published them on; Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, TikTok & YouTube.

Finding a style that works for you is the key to engagement, so that you connect with people and more importantly that they connect with you.

My Facebook Reform page was also critical when it came to finding volunteers to help me canvassing.

There are two critical factors when it comes to campaigning, the first is raising money & the second and possibly the most important is finding volunteers.

I have been incredibly lucky that so many great people have sought me out & offered to help. Campaigning is a team event & building that team was without doubt the key for us.

As a new Party we are still building our support so we have fewer activists at our disposal. Witnessing the scale of the support some of the other parties received makes you realise what is possible given the time

Our aim was to knock every door in Mid Beds but we fell short. We did knock just over 40,000 which was an amazing achievement.

If nothing else, we earned the respect of the 3 legacy Party candidates who all commented to me about the efforts we achieved. In the General Election we will be on a more level playing field as spending by the big three will be capped & their activists will be spread out across many more constituencies.

So, what did I learn during my 132 day electioneering baptism?

1/ If you don't have a Norma Saggers as your campaign manager, go and find one. She was incredible & kept us all going.

2/ You will never have enough volunteers, it's never too early to recruit them & never stop searching for more. (when you do get volunteers, do not break them by asking too much of them!)

3/ You will never raise enough money to fund everything you need to do (well, not in a by-election anyway). My amazing donors provided a total of £13,000 which I used to push 1.3 million messages into the constituency via social media.

We achieved our first goal which was for everyone to know me, the Party & our policies.

We received more votes than any other Reform candidate so far & in the process thwarted the Tories attempts to be reelected.

I owe Norma, my wonderful volunteers & amazing donors a huge thank you. None of this would have happened without you & I will forever be grateful.
