



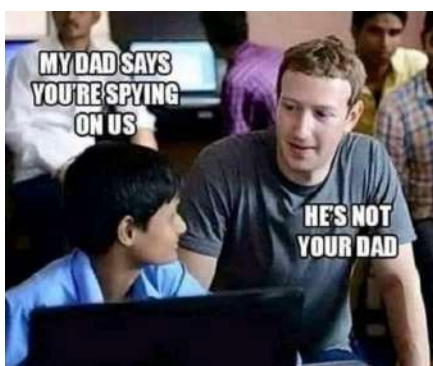

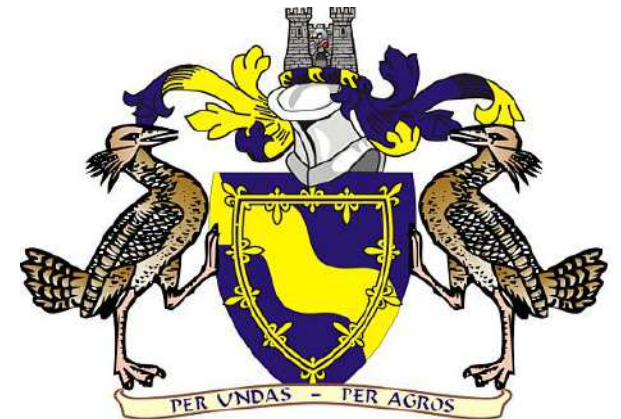

Social Housing Scandals in Hertfordshire

With Matt Goodwin recently putting the spotlight on how much social housing is being allocated to those not born in Britain, you might be wondering what on earth is going on with Social Housing providers in this country?

Anonymous sources have confirmed to me that the story about Social Housing in the UK is far darker than anyone appreciates, and what's happening in Hertfordshire is no exception.

Mums Out – Migrants In

Few will argue that providing social housing for the disabled, the homeless and the most vulnerable in society is a good thing.

But the priorities of Social Housing providers have been corrupted by government failures. One example is a scheme in Hemel Hempstead and St Albans, originally a Mother and Baby service, designed to provide accommodation to homeless single mothers and their infant children, has changed its service to accommodate “Separated Children” – translation – illegal immigrants.

That's right, illegal migrants landing on our shores, with “no paperwork” are declaring themselves to be 16, some less convincingly than others! In any case they're being taken at their word when they land in Kent and shipped into Social Housing schemes across the country.

Why would a Social Housing provider do such a thing? Money. Along with the migrants moving in, extensive renovations have been carried out. New kitchens, new bathrooms, and new furniture has been put in, paid most likely by the government using your taxes.

In exchange for their cooperation, one can only assume Social Housing providers are getting their assets upgraded for free, a kickback in exchange for turving out single mums and helping solve a problem the government is wholly responsible for, all on your dime!

Dodgy Hiring Practices

There are few professions as poorly paid as Support Workers, they do valuable work looking after drug addicts, single mums, the homeless and the disabled living in Social Housing schemes in exchange for little more than minimum wage.

How can an entire profession continue to cope with increased demand and chronic government underfunding? The solution is to hire immigrants.

Nearly all providers are visa sponsors, enabling an undercutting of wages, with the promise of a ticket into the country. Thousands of migrants from India and Nigeria in particular, are entering the profession.

One of the saddest factors is that some of these migrants are skilled midwives, nurses, graduates and even businessmen from their native country. Who wins when Lagos loses a trained midwife and Britain gains a cheap Support Worker?

Not only that, but an industry of unregulated “care staff providers” has emerged, with firms offering sponsorship for “40 hour” contracts. Whether they are giving migrants 40 hours a week of work remains to be seen, but what these contractors enable migrants to do is work up to 20 hours a week at any Social Housing provider without needing serious right-to-work checks.

An anonymous source confirmed that those

seeking 20 hours or less always seem to be able to make their shifts, and it never seems to clash with the “work” they have to do for their visa sponsor. Funny that!

There is clearly a grift going on and no one is interested in investigating whether these firms are bogus operators or not.

It's also a huge problem for tenants in vulnerable schemes across Hertfordshire. With migrant Support Staff coming from completely different backgrounds and often with poor language skills, what chance does a disabled, homeless, or suicidal tenant have when they're in crisis?

Empty and Misused Properties

One unnamed source in a Housing team commented that one would be amazed at how many properties are either dormant or are being misused.

When someone is allocated a property and moves in, the rent is often paid entirely by Housing Benefit, going straight to the provider.

As a result, it's not unheard of for a tenant to up-sticks, die or even go to prison and it will take months, even years before Social Housing providers figure out there's no one in the property.

Providers do what they can to get police to do welfare checks if a tenant is unresponsive, but they're often ignored, or checks are done superficially.

On top of that, there are many cases of social properties being turned into cannabis farms.

Tenants are either part of the drug trade or in some more horrific cases, they are

coerced by loan sharks into growing drugs to pay off their debts.

With social housing stock representing 17% of UK accommodation, serious questions need to be asked as to how this stock is being used and whether providers in Hertfordshire and across the nation are doing the right thing by the taxpayer.

In St Albans, John Dowdle had also been holding coffee mornings at the Three Hammers in Chiswell Green to listen to the concerns of St Albans residents.

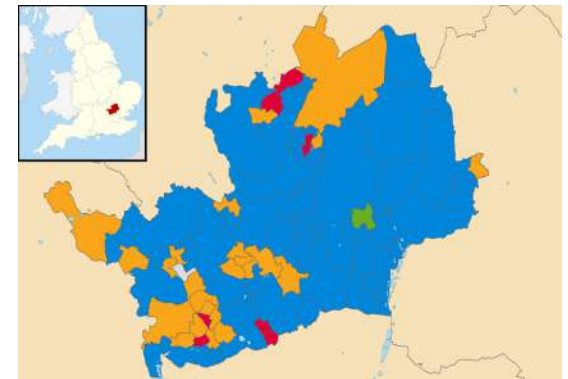
