



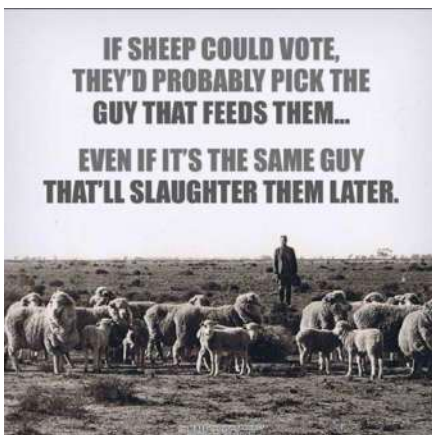

Good news for members. During the next few months our Party Leader, Richard, will be visiting each County across the Region to meet with as many of you as possible. Details as soon as they are available.

The main focus for the Region is the Mid-Bedfordshire By-Election, we are continuing with our campaigning and canvassing in the hope that eventually Ms Dorries will resign and we will have a date to work towards.

If anyone would like to join us to help out you will be very welcome.

There is still a lot happening across the six Counties.

This week we see four newly appointed Spokesmen and Women in Norfolk, Hertfordshire, Essex and Cambridgeshire. This along with many other key reasons, is why I believe a party such as Reform is needed now more than ever and is why I finally decided that I had to get involved.

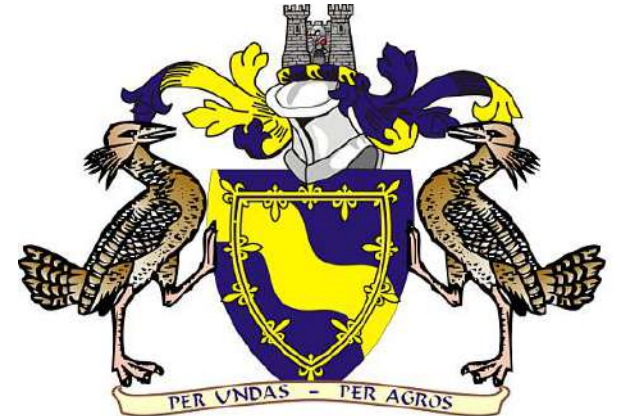

With 10 out of 12 Hertfordshire spokespeople in place, the individual campaigns are kicking off across the county.

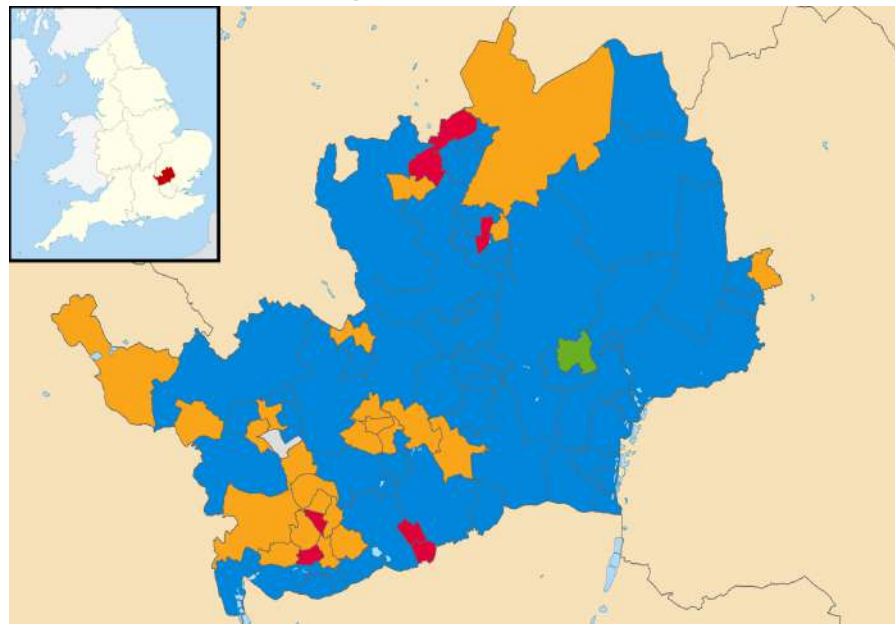
I joined a couple of Reform colleagues for their initial meetings, getting a sense of what members are concerned about and planning the campaign ahead.

Darren Selkus (Hertsmere) brought Reform supporters together at the Hart & Spool in Borehamwood, it was a lively meeting with people expressing their concerns over energy security, Brexit betrayal and mass-immigration, both legal and illegal.

On Brexit and immigration, we all feel the same way, but energy policy? Well, that can be much more divisive, but Darren expertly brought everyone together, reminding us all that it's the cost of energy that's killing this economy, and to make it cheaper, all options need to be on the table.



Amo Amato (Stevenage) started the plan for his campaign at the Standing Order in the old town. Amo made a powerful argument for activism in local politics, he said that one Reform UK candidate might get 50-60 votes at a local election, but with 10 or 12 candidates, standing in every ward, you're looking at 500 – 750 votes, and that builds serious momentum. What was clear from everyone was the feeling that Stevenage has been



blighted by the number of high-rise flats going up: it's ruined the character of the town, ruined any sense of community and is simply not what people wanted.

Plans are now being put into place for street stalls, leafleting and canvassing and we're also starting to put content on YouTube and other social media. August is also going to be busy in the west of Hertfordshire as a slew of meetings are planned across Berkhamsted, Hemel Hempstead and Harpenden to get members out.

Going to these meetings, you can't help notice that there's a huge appetite to do something! While a lot of people across the country seem depressed and resigned to things only getting worse, those in Reform UK know a brighter future is possible and we're doing something about it.
